

Manchester: Two hurt in crash

Rescue workers use the Jaws of Life to remove a victim after a two-vehicle crash about 2:30 p.m. Thursday at the intersection of County Road 7 and Outlet Road in Manchester. Ontario County deputies said Paul W. Conklin, 17, of 71 Church St., Phelps, failed to stop at a stop sign and collided with a pickup truck driven by Paul O. Hamelinck, 57, of 165 Landon Ave., Newark. Hamelinck was unconscious at the scene and was flown to Strong Memorial Hospital by Mercy Flight with a head injury. He remains in the hospital in guarded condition. Conklin suffered lacerations and a possible head injury and was taken to Strong by Finger Lakes Ambulance. He was treated and released. Conklin was ticketed for failing to stop at the stop sign.
